4	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Review</b> of main ideas in the article is complete. Displays a clear and full understanding of the topic and the facts expressed in the article. Relevant, clear and descriptive examples/facts/details from the article are presented to support key topic(s). At least the required amount is included, with possible more.</li><li>• <b>Reaction</b> includes a high level and thorough of key agreements/disagreements along with a personal opinion. Each includes specific reasoning based on details and examples for support.</li><li>• <b>Conclusion</b> includes clear evidence of thinking beyond the surface of the topic.</li><li>• Written in proper paragraph format. Complete sentences, correct spelling, punctuation and grammar. Organization is very clear and flows well.</li><li>• Structure directions are followed.</li></ul>
3	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Review</b> of main ideas in the article is mainly complete and displays a good understanding of the topic. Clear examples/facts/details from the article are presented to support key topic(s). Required amount included.</li><li>• <b>Reaction</b> includes key agreements/disagreements and a personal opinion about the topic. Details and examples to support are presented.</li><li>• <b>Conclusion</b> displays a satisfactory attempt to connect and relate the topic beyond the main ideas.</li><li>• Written in proper paragraph format. Complete sentences, correct spelling, punctuation and grammar. There is an appropriate level of organizing. There may be very little amount of errors that do not interfere with the overall assignment.</li><li>• Structure directions are followed.</li></ul>
2	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <b>Review</b> of main ideas in the article is somewhat complete and displays a partial understanding of the topic. Limited examples/facts/details from the article are presented to support key topic(s). Required amount may or may not be included.</li><li>• <b>Reaction</b> includes some key agreements/disagreements and a personal opinion about the topic.</li><li>• <b>Conclusion</b> displays a satisfactory attempt to connect and relate the topic beyond the main ideas.</li><li>• There may be significant amount of errors with one or more of the following: proper paragraphs, complete sentences, correct spelling, punctuation and grammar and organizing.</li><li>• Structure directions are somewhat followed.</li></ul>
1	One or more of the areas within a 3 lack a significant amount of information, or is missing or there is a minimal attempt made.
0	There is a minimum attempt given to complete this assignment.
