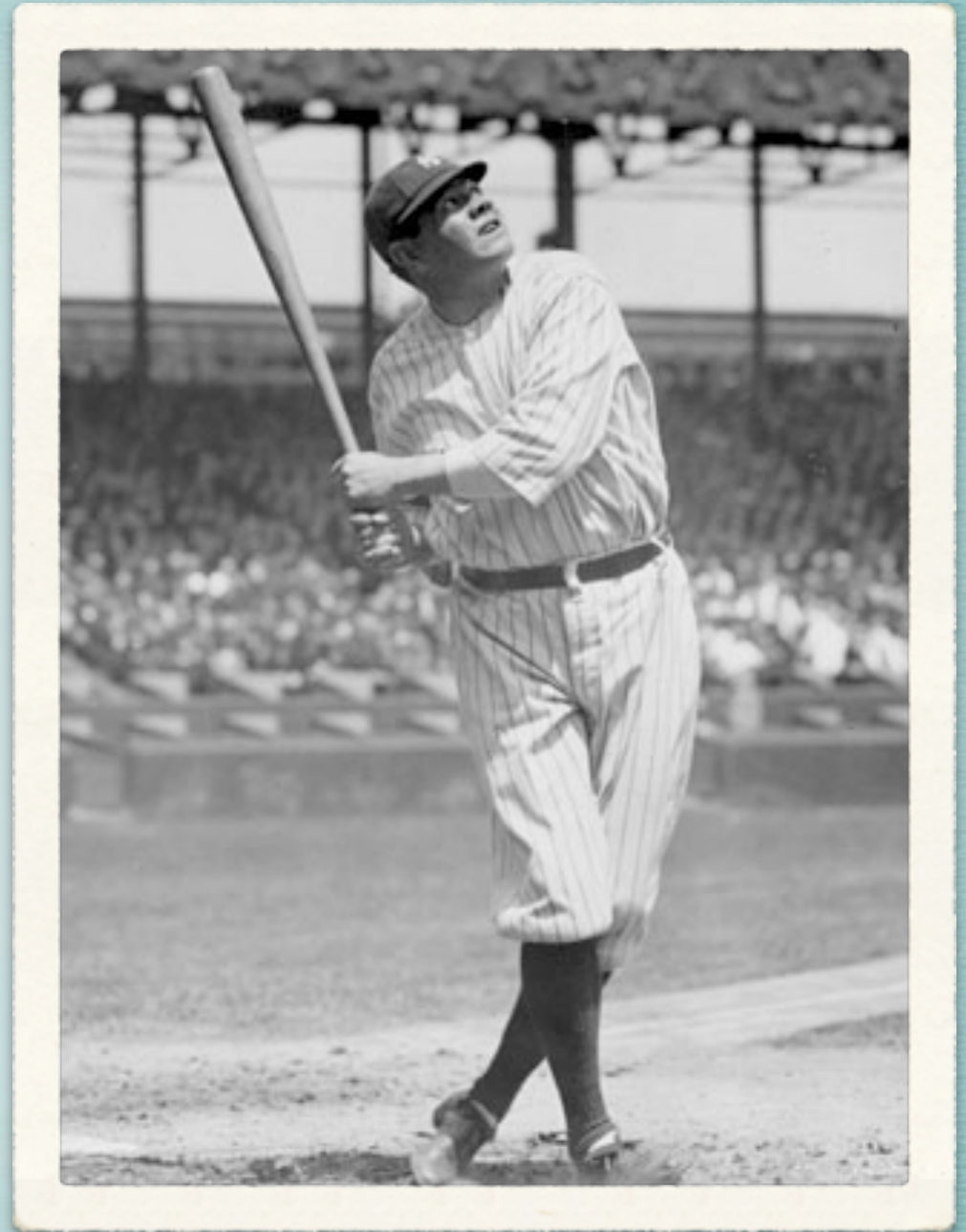

# *Yankee Stadium*

After a short time with the Braves, Babe retired in 1935.

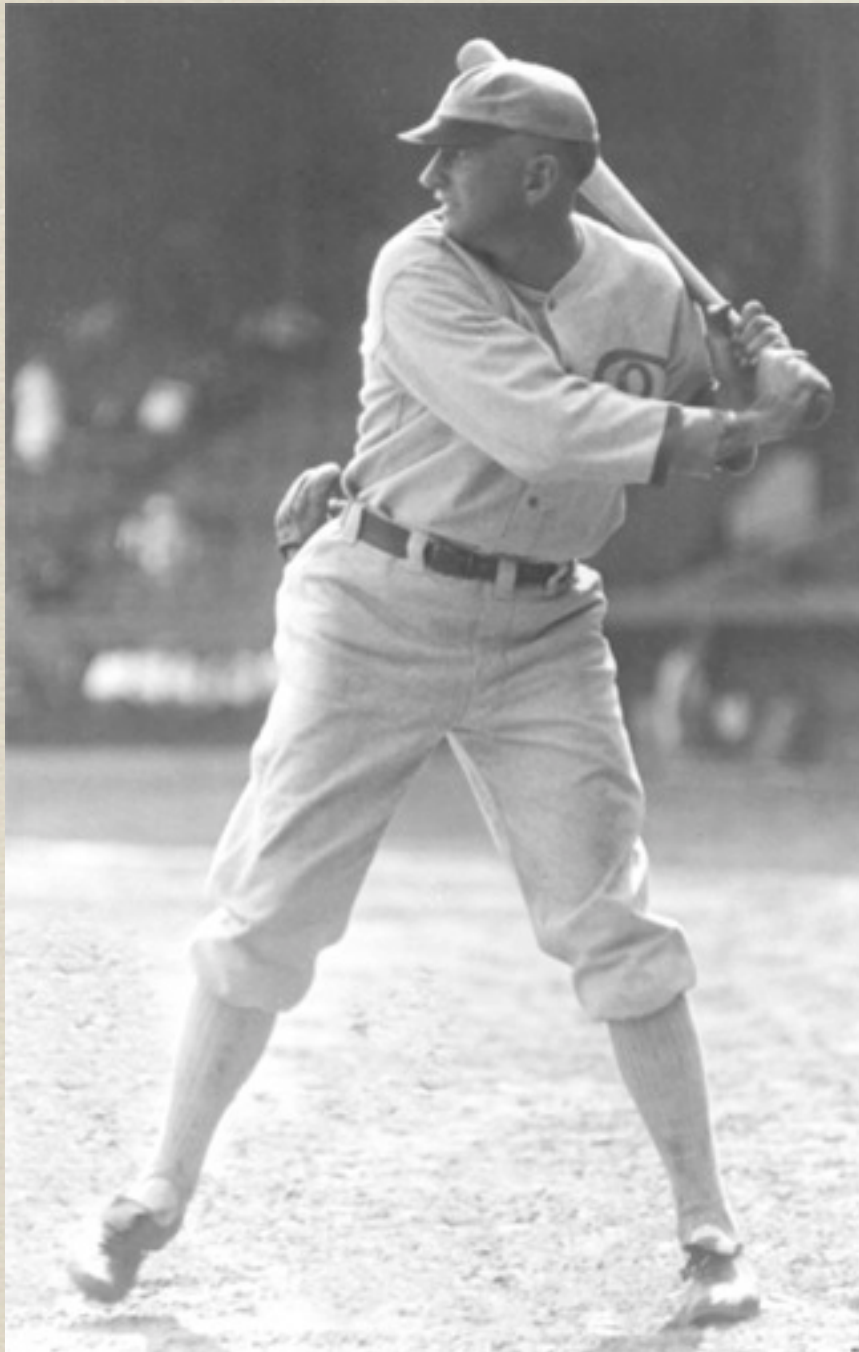
Babe has hit 714 homeruns,





# *Shoeless Joe Jackson*

Real name: Joseph Jefferson Jackson



He was associated with the Black Sox Scandal in which members of the 1919 Chicago White Sox conspired to fix the World Series. In result, he was banned from playing after the 1920 season.

# *Red Grange*



Harold Edward “Red” Grange was a college and professional American football halfback for the University of Illinois and the Chicago Bears.

He was a charter member for both the College and Pro Football Hall of Fame.

In 2008 he was named the greatest college football player of all time by ESPN.
